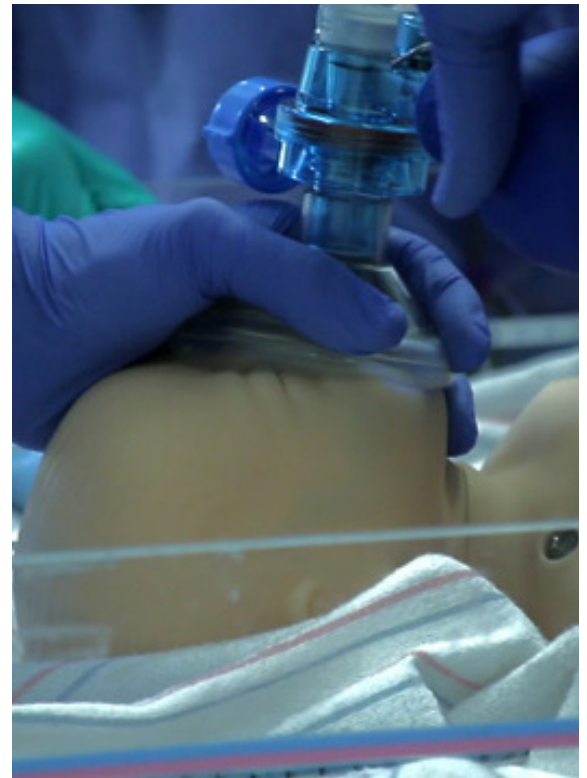
Course Synopsis
